There was so much to do to get the club back on track, and, after years of speculation, we had finally received official confirmation that we would need to move. My greatest fear was that the Token 3 Club would close its doors, leaving our recovering community in need."

"It is with immense gratitude that I can report the Token 3 Club is stronger and more able to serve our community than ever before. In April 2019, we moved into a beautifully renovated facility with more space and accessibility. As a result, we now host 62 twelve-step meetings weekly and serve upwards of 1,500 people. None of this would have been possible without the commitment of our board of directors, and the support of our members and community partners. I am confident, and so very thankful that the Token 3 Club will be able to continue its service to our recovery community well into the future."

How do we reach suffering individuals with our message of hope? One important way is to educate the medical community who often treats the addict/alcoholic before the problem is recognized.

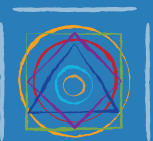

The program, coordinated by Dr. Steve Wheeler, Associate Dean for Admissions, School of Medicine, offered a brief history of the Token 3 Club and the services we offer. This was followed by Dr. Roszell's presentation "Helping

Your Patients with Substance Abuse" which outlined screening questions, diagnostic tools, and references for additional providers that treat substance abuse patients.
